## Facilities

Fully accessible building, ramps to all entrances and all rooms on the ground floor.

Off road parking for up to 70 cars including spaces for disabled drivers next to the main entrance.



## Main Hall

A large, bright and airy main hall (18m x 8m) Seating capacity of 150 theatre style or 120 café style.

Bar in the main hall with two drinks fridges, shelves & sink unit.

Wooden Sprung floor in the main hall “a dancers dream” is how one user described it.

Raised Staging area and behind stage storage and changing facility.

Projector screen suitable for linking to tablets iPad laptops etc Wi-Fi enabled

Suitable for a stage production, wedding venue, party, social occasion, anniversary party, business meeting place, presentation etc.

## Meeting Room

Looking out over the garden area at the back of the hall is a small but beautifully presented meeting room (5.6m x 4.8m)

## The Kitchen

Full catering standard kitchen which includes, microwave, dishwasher, cooker, warming ovens, kettle, hot water urn, extractor fans, a modern island unit and a full range of crockery and cutlery included in the hire price.

The kitchen could also be the focus for cookery based teaching events, workshops and perhaps even a Bake off event.

Separate entrances to the meeting room and kitchen at the rear of the hall.
